1. Itinerary

FIRST DAY EVENING

- 5:00 p.m. – Check-in
- 6:00 p.m. – Welcome Show
- 6:15 p.m. – Catered Dinner
- 7:00 p.m. – Activities Conducted
- 10:00 p.m. – Get ready for bed
- 11:00 p.m. – Lights out

SECOND DAY MORNING

- 6:45 a.m. – Wake-up/pack-up/load gear in vehicles
- 7:45 a.m. – Catered Breakfast

4. General Admission Ticket

- This program comes with a General Admission ticket for each registrant. You have **two options** on when to utilize this ticket (**selected during registration**). Pack 797 recommends using the General Admission Tickets for Sunday 10/27.
- **Before Your Event:** Use your General Admission ticket *before* the Overnight Experience. Arrive at Space Center Houston and pick up your Overnight wristbands from the Guest Services desk right inside the center.
 - If you choose this option, **upon arrival check-in with the Guest Services desk at the main entrance.** They will have a roster with General Admission tickets in order to let you in. Please note that they may ask for verification of your identity.
 - You may purchase additional General Admission tickets can be purchased for \$12.95 each, should you have family members that wish to join you for your General Admission experience. Additional guests will not be able to stay past 5:45 PM.
 - **Note: With this option, you will be expected to leave at 10:00 AM following the tram tour to Johnson Space Center's Building 9 and Rocket Park on the morning following the Overnight Experience.**
- **After Your Event:** Use your General Admission ticket immediately *after* your Overnight Experience. After breakfast, an IMAX film in Space Center Theater, and a tram tour to Johnson Space Center's Building 9 and Rocket Park, you will be released to explore Space Center Houston; experience various live shows, exhibits, and photo opportunities at your own pace.
 - Additional General Admission tickets can be purchased for \$12.95 each, should you have family members that wish to join you for your General Admission experience.
 - Additional guests will join you at 10:30 AM at the center. If you wish them to join you earlier than 10:30 M for the morning tram at 9:00 AM, this will need to be cleared by the coordinator or the lead instructor the previous evening.
 - With this option, you may stay until closing time on Sunday.

5. Travel Tips

- Remember to search for "Space Center Houston" and not "NASA" or "Johnson Space Center" on your GPS.

6. Uniform and Recommended Items

- All Scouts: Saturday 10/26 Scouts should arrive in full Scouts Uniform. For Sunday 10/27 Scouts will wear the Yellow Activity Shirt.
- Den Leads and Assistant Den Leads will wear full uniform on Saturday and Sunday Polo Leaders Shirt.
- Clothing: Comfortable, casual clothes and good walking shoes are recommended.
 - Remember to bring a jacket or sweater no matter what time of year you are coming. The building often gets cold in the evenings.
 - Pajamas and slip-on shoes for the evening (shoes must always be worn when walking around the center or outside for safety reasons).

- Food/Snacks: Snacks and drinks (non-alcoholic only) may be brought during the evening portion of the event. These must be consumed outdoors or inside our Food Lab.
- Luggage: Backpacks, duffle bags, or small roller suitcases ("carry-on" sized) are ideal.
- Basic Toiletries: Toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, and hairbrushes are ideal. Wet wipes are a great way to freshen up since we do not have showers.
- Charging Banks: **Power outlets may not be available to everyone.** Charging banks are a great idea and allow you to charge your device without an outlet.
- Money: If you would like to purchase an exclusive Overnight t-shirt, or even something from our gift shop (Space Traders) or Food Lab during your general admission, it is recommended to bring some additional money.

7. Prohibited Items

- Please keep in mind that you will be sleeping near other guests. We ask that you show the same courtesy and respect to them that you would like them to show you.
- Things that are prohibited at Overnight Experiences:
 - Glow sticks (flashlights and phone lights are ok)
 - Electrical hair appliances (blow dryers, straighteners, curling irons, etc.)
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Unregistered guests
 - Only registered participants can attend an Overnight Experience.
 - Chaperones are not permitted to bring any children who are not registered or who do not meet the designated age level for an Overnight Experience.

8. Activities

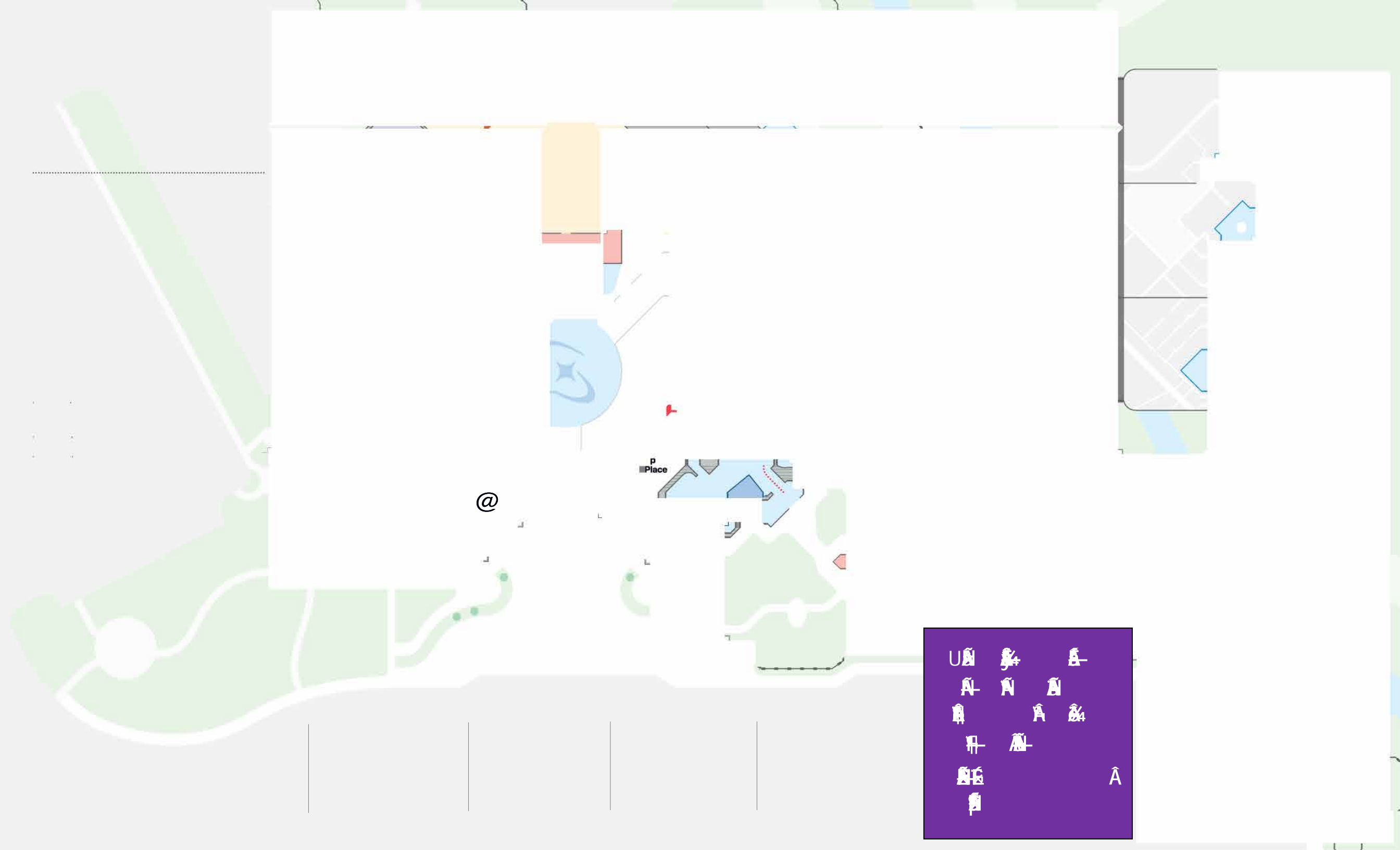
- Overnight-exclusive activities will be spread throughout the center for you and your children to experience and enjoy. These activities will only be available during the evening, so we recommend visiting those before visiting various exhibits as these will be there during general admission.
- **Adult Role:** Your role as an adult is very important during the event. The activities are designed for you to participate with your children and enjoy this unique experience together. Please help them make memories that will last for a lifetime! Education instructors are going to rely on you to participate and be a part of the activities. They will interact with you as well and will get you involved, so "be prepared!"
- **Two-Deep Leadership:** Our policy at Space Center Houston is that a child is never left alone. They are either with one of our instructors, another child, or an adult chaperone. We ask them to find a "Space Buddy" and they are supposed to stay together during the activity portion of the night.

9. Meals

- Dinner and breakfast will be provided. No other food will be available at the Center during evening activities.
- You are allowed to bring small snacks or drinks. We ask that any snacks or drinks other than water be consumed outside or in the Food Lab where you eat dinner.
- We do serve gluten-free, pork-free, vegan, and vegetarian variations to the meal. Please be aware that these had to be ordered during your registration. **We are unable to modify food selections within 2 weeks of an event.**

 - Grilled Chicken Parmesan
 - Pasta
 - Steamed Veggies
 - Cookie
 - Water
 - **GF Variation:** GF Pasta, GF Cookie, No roll
 - **Pork-Free Variation:** No Change
 - **Vegetarian:** Beyond Meat Parmesan instead of Chicken
 - **Vegan:** Beyond Meat instead of Chicken, No cheese, Vegan Cookie
- **Breakfast**
 - Fresh Fruit
 - Muffin
 - Apple or Orange Juice
 - Coffee (adults only)
 - **GF Variation:** Breakfast Bowl, GF Muffin
 - **Pork-Free Variation:** Egg and Cheese Burrito
 - **Vegetarian:** Egg and Cheese Burrito
 - **Vegan:** Vegan Breakfast Bowl
- **Message from Our Caterers:** *Please be aware that items are prepared in a facility handling and preparing with egg, milk, wheat, shellfish, soy, peanut and tree nut products, and other potential allergens. If there is a concern with the dietary requirements, individual bagged meals are permitted to be brought onsite for your event.
