Communication

I,

- There will be 9 (2.5 hours) pack meetings, 2 Camps and 1 Day Camp throughout the year beginning September thru May.
- The meeting is always on a Sunday, usually from 9:30am to 12:00pm. However, there might be a field trip on other days of the week and/or change in meeting venue.
- The Assembly will promptly start at 9:30am. The Scout is expected to arrive before 9:30am and be present in the Assembly for all the meetings.
- Scouts must wear a uniform shirt at all meetings and events. At the camps, scouts must wear Pack T-Shirts.
- The annual expenditure for the Scout is approximately \$250.00. Payment is due at the time of Registration (Check or Money Order Only). Payable to "IMST Pack 797"
- Parents have to complete REQUIRED (YPT) training every 2 years at <u>my.scouting.org</u>. YPT is REQUIRED to attend camps.
- All concerns and questions should be directed to the proper channel.

(Den Leader >>> Cub Master >>> Pack Chairman >>> AKYSB)

- There will be TWO camps during the year. Attending ONE camp is Mandatory. Scouts who MISSES BOTH CAMPS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER in the following year.
 - o Camps are usually from Friday evening to Sunday morning until you are dismissed by the Cub Master. REC will be missed and it will not be considered as a valid reason for missing camp.
 - At the sole discretion of Pack Management, consideration will be given for VERY UNUSUAL circumstances, including but not limited to sickness, emergency or other such matters. Management's decision will be FINAL.

Behavior/Discipline

- There is a <u>ZERO TOLERANCE</u> policy for bullying, improper language and/or behavior by Cub Scouts and Parents. Non- Compliance will RESULT in IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL from the Pack membership and program.
- Cub Scouts should be on their best behavior at all times, when wearing their uniform.

Attendance

In order to get the most out of the Cub Scouts experience, an attendance policy has been set. Den Leaders will closely monitor attendance for Scouts.

Tardies/Absence

- o 3 Tardies = 1 Absence
 - Arriving after the attendance is taken is considered TARDY (Late).
- o 4 Absences = Dismissal from Cub Scout Pack 797 (No Exceptions)
 - Only 3 Absences are allowed,

This is a parent's driven program. Full participation, including conducting Den meetings and/or any other capacity is encouraged. The program can only be successful with 100% participation. There will be activities assigned to do with your Scout at home. It is the parent's responsibility to be aware of it and complete it.
